




Set-Up

1. Drill 3 x M8 holes to match the holes located in the Mounting Bracket.
2. Connect the hose reel to the Mounting Bracket with the Pivot Pin.





It is recommended to install the mounting bracket at least 80cm from the floor.





Hose Connection

1. Pull the copper ring backwards, and visually check the U-shaped groove stuck to the cylindrical pin.




2. Loosen the cooper ring to rebound, and visually check the U-shaped groove top to the cylindrical pin.



Operation

1. Pull on the hose and you can manually set the lock positions.
2. When the hose is fully extended, do not continue pulling on the hose.
3. When the hose is retracting, keep hold of the hose nozzle until the hose is fully retracted into the unit.



Troubleshooting

The most common malfunction is that the hose cannot be retracted automatically after fully extending the hose.

This often happens due to the hose being locked at the very end position of the locking point where there is no more extra hose to be pulled out. There are two ways to solve this:

1. Hold the hose at the yellow warning mark and pull with a jerking motion until the hose retracts.
2. Place the reel down on its right side, then pull on the hose until it retracts.
