



MOTORCYCLE LIFT

500KG (1,100LBS)

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Max. Capacity	500kg (1100lbs)
Max. Height	400mm (15-3/4")
Min. Height	95mm (3-3/4")
Platform Size	450mm x 150mm (17-23/32" x 5-29/32")

Caution

1. The maximum load is 1,100lbs (500kg). DO NOT exceed this rated capacity.
2. Ensure saddles are fastened and secured before lifting.
3. Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the work area.
4. Wear ANSI approved safety goggles when operating the lift.
5. Only use this lift on a large, stable, level, dry and non-slippery motorcycle lift platform. Keep the surface clean, tidy and free from unrelated materials and ensure that there is adequate lighting.
6. Ensure wing brackets and base are bolted down into concrete with dynabolts.
7. Ensure wing brackets and case are down onto a compatible larger bike lift with washers, spring washers, nuts and bolts.
8. Ensure jack is always used with saddles and is positioned perpendicular to bike.
9. Always keep your hands and feet away from working area.
10. DO NOT allow untrained persons to operate the lift
11. DO NOT make any modifications to this lift.
12. DO NOT expose the lift to rain or snow.

Maintenance

1. When not in use, the lift must be stored in the lowest position in a dry location.
2. Keep the lift clean and wipe off any oil or grease. Lubricate all moving parts.
3. Before each use check all parts. If any part of the lift is damaged or suspect remove the lift from service and take necessary action to repair.
