



SNORKEL KIT FOR TOYOTA HILUX 4x4 25 SERIES

USER MANUAL

Some tools required for installing:

- **Hole Saw (108mm)**
- **Step Drill**
- **Spanner (13mm)**

1. Before installation, check that the snorkel application is compatible with your vehicle.



2. Remove the right-hand mudguard liner and air intake duct.

PETROL: Remove the air cleaner intake hose and cyclonic pre-cleaner.

DIESEL: Remove the air cleaner assembly.

3. Apply masking tape to the right-hand front mudguard and windscreen pillar.

4. Tape the mounting template to the mudguard, making sure it is lined up with top of the mudguard (bonnet opening) and the rear of the mudguard (door opening).




5. Using a felt tipped pen, mark all holes through the mounting template onto the mudguard. Remove the template.


7. De-burr and rust-proof all holes (this applies to all holes drilled after this step).

6. Drill the mounting holes to 16mm and using a 108mm hole saw, cut the remaining hole for the air entry hose.


8. Using a thread-locking compound, screw all studs into the snorkel body and loosely attach the pillar mounting bracket to the snorkel using the supplied M6 bolts.



9. Hold the snorkel body in position on the mudguard and mark the position of the pillar mounting bracket holes on the pillar. Remove the snorkel, and remove the bracket from the snorkel.




10. Drill the pillar mounting bracket holes to 7.5mm - when drilling, drill through outer skin of the pillar only, and no further. Apply silicone sealant to the holes and insert the mounting plugs.



11. Attach the mounting bracket using three self-tapping screws provided.


12. Install the snorkel body to the vehicle using the supplied M8 Nyloc nuts and body washers, and attach it to the pillar mounting bracket using the supplied M6 bolts.

13. Attach the rubber joiner to the snorkel and secure it in position with the supplied hose clamp.




PETROL ENGINE


14. Using a file or similar, remove the three raised plastic sections from the cyclonic pre-cleaner to allow the rubber adaptor to be fitted over it.



15. Apply silicone sealant to the outside of the rubber joiner in the engine bay and attach the rubber adaptor to it using the supplied hose clamp.



16. Re-install the cyclonic air intake and the air intake hose to the air cleaner.


17. Re-install the air cleaner assembly and attach to rubber joiner using hose clamp provided.

ALL MODELS

18. Check all hose connections and air box for potential leaks and seal as required.

19. Re-install the guard liner.

20. Fit the air ram and secure it with the supplied hose clamp.
