




Bike Carrier Rack C03

User Manual
[Revision 2.0 March 2016]

PLEASE READ THIS MANUAL CAREFULLY BEFORE USE

Safety

- Always ensure that the rack is firmly secured.
- Always ensure that the straps are safely secured.
- Never exceed more than 45kg!
- Plan your trip. Allow access to boot when needed. Secure bikes with extra rope is travelling in car of speeds higher than 60km.
- Ensure your vehicle is suitable for this type of rack - Generally suited for hatchbacks and sedans.
- Ensure your registration plate is visible.
- Ensure your brake and indication lights are visible.
- Ensure the rack is level and even.
- Always ensure your bikes are properly secured! This means that sourcing extra ropes or straps may be a necessity!
- Never use rack if there is ANY damage to the product.
- Check with your local roads and traffic regulations for any other possible rules to follow.
- **A** must not be more than 1200 mm and should be kept to a minimum as much as possible
- **B** must not be more than 60% of the wheelbase
- **C** must not be more than 150 mm



Set-up

Step 1

Loosen the rack and open up to roughly 90° and lightly tighten by hand (so it can still move).



Step 2

Without any straps, place the rack on the boot of your car and adjust the angle to best fit your vehicle.

Ensure that the rack is no more than 30° while making it as level as possible. Once the best fit has been found, tighten the rack.




Step 3

Locate the 6 provided straps and bend the outer strap holder outwards.



Step 4

Loop the strap from the inside and hook onto the lower, upper and side sections of your boot.



Step 5

Ensure that the lower straps are over the lower section of the rack.
This is to secure the rack.



Step 6

Tie the excess loose strapping onto the taut section of the strap and secure to prevent loose material.
NEVER CUT IT!

Step 7

Enjoy your bike ride with a safe trip back home!
