# Safety

- This heated towel rack is not intended to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given proper supervision or instructions concerning the use of the heated towel rack by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the heated towel rack.
- In order to avoid any potential hazards for very young children, this heated towel rack should be installed so that the lowest heated rail is at least 600mm above the floor.
- Make sure to clean the heated towel rack first before using it.
- Wipe the surface clean with a soft, damp cloth. Never use abrasive cleaners on the heated towel rack.
- Please wipe the heated towel rack with a dry cloth after an extended time without using it.
- Make sure to use the right plug and power rating according to the heated towel rack's instruction.
- It is recommended that a professional electrician do the electrical works. Do not attempt to adjust the power and/or cable while the heated towel rack is still turned on!



# Installation

## Tools required (not supplied):



Large, flat  
screwdriver



Impact drill




Hammer




Tape measure


1. Place the rack on the wall of where you'd like to install it. Mark out (either by drawing around the wall attachments or draw lines with a level) where the holes are to be drilled.



2. Drill the hole on the right position. Secure the 8mm masonry wall plugs (B) into the wall. Insert the wall base (E) into the hole. Insert the long screw (C) through the centre of the wall to support the wall base (E) tightly into the wall.




3. Place the towel rack onto the wall bases that were previously installed and ensure they align properly. Make adjustments if needed.



4. Fit the towel rack onto the wall bases and screw the small 5mm screws (D) into the wall attachments to secure.

Power can now be connected and turned on when needed.
