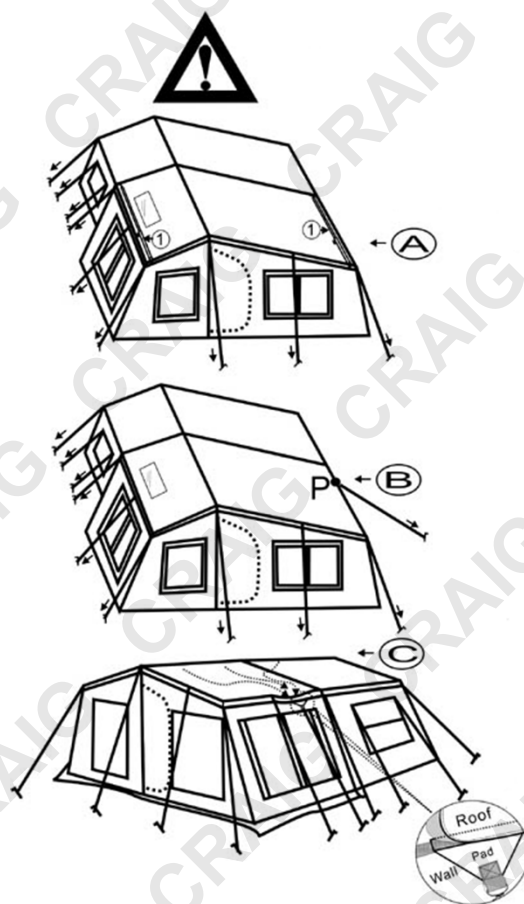

SAFETY REMINDERS AND USAGE

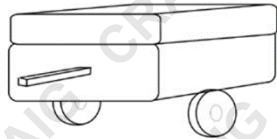
1. Do not install the poles very tight or very loose, otherwise it will cause difficulty to attach the Annex Walls to the tent.
2. When using the tent in rainy days, please see below for CAUTION FOR USING IN RAINY DAYS.
3. Please attach the rope to the top of each vertical pole, NOT the hook of Rubber Band.
4. Please open/close the zippers on windows/doors very carefully after securing the pegs around the tents and adjust the poles to right place to make sure the tent becomes flat.

CAUTION FOR USING IN RAINY DAYS

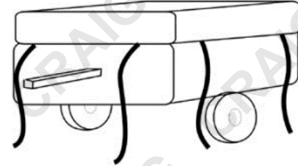
1. To secure the pegs to the ground around the tent, adjust the poles to its correct position and tighten the ropes to make sure the tent roof is flat.
2. To remove two poles 1 shown on right picture A, place the waterproof cap into the top of each vertical pole and tighten the ropes of Annex walls one by one.
3. On point P shown on right picture B, please add a water-guide pad between the Velcro's of awning and annex wall, then tighten its rope as shown on right picture C.
4. Please do the same for the second awning



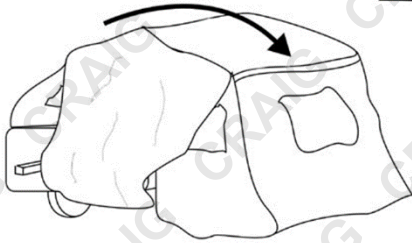

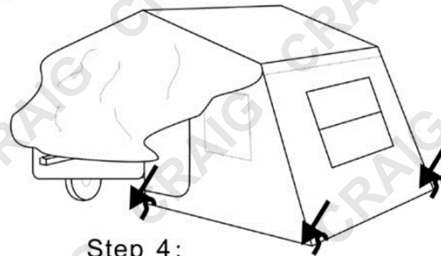
Step 1:
Remove the cover.



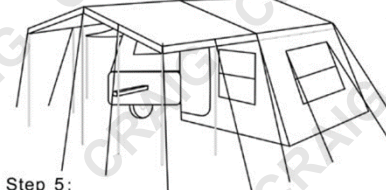
Step 2:

tightening rope.



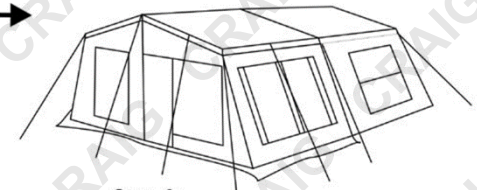
Step 3:

to another side.



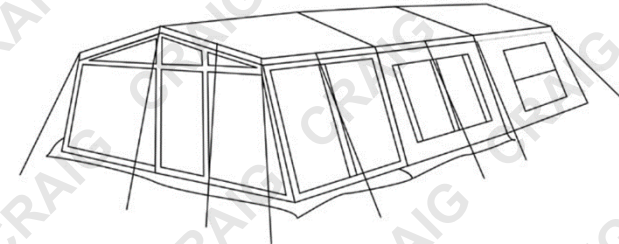
Step 4:

the edge to the awning

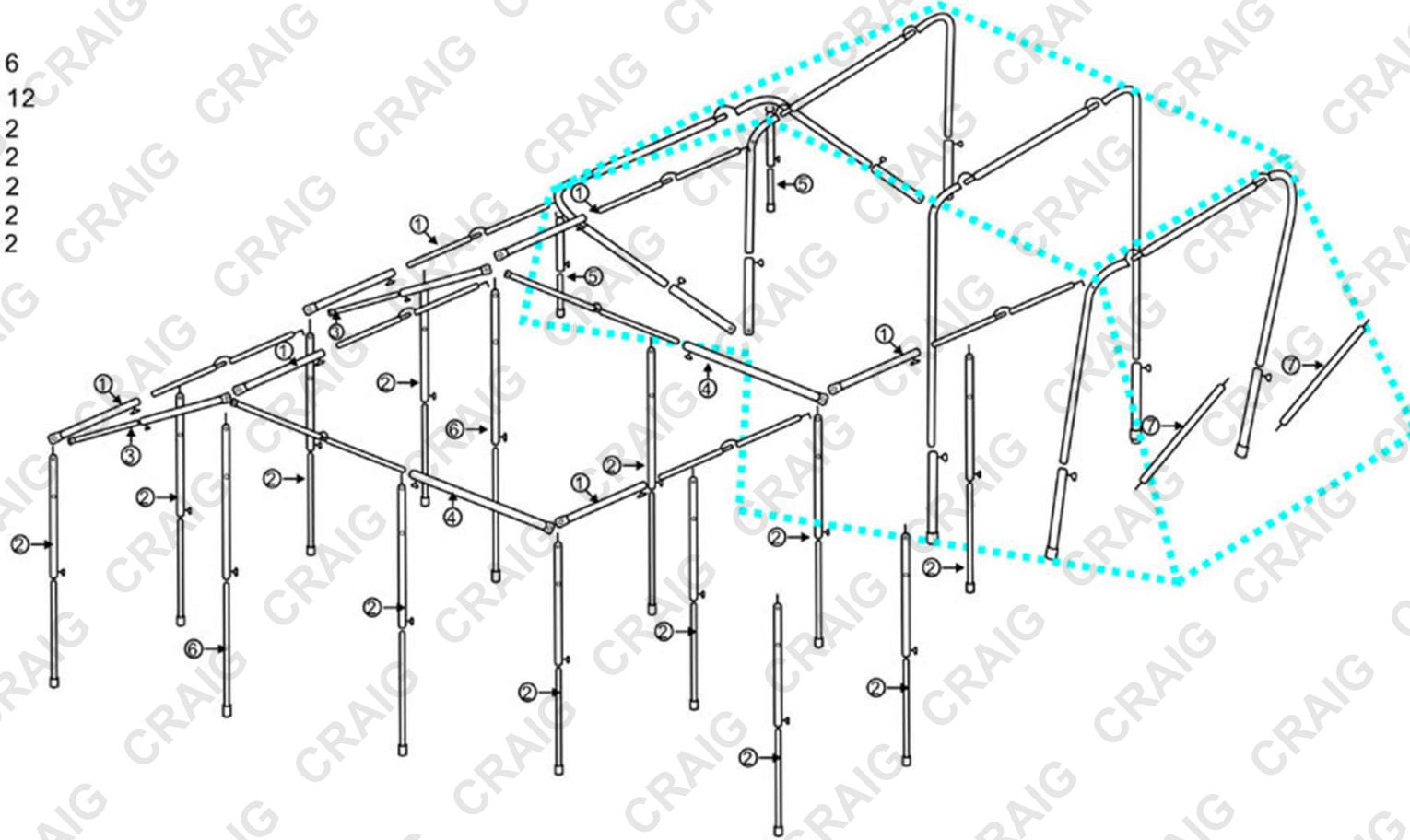


Step 7: For the second Awning & Annex, please repeat doing Step 5 and Step 6
