Executive Office Chair with 8-Point Massage System

User Manual

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Safety

The following persons must not use this massage chair:

- Persons who have been instructed by a doctor to avoid massage therapy.
- Examples: Persons with thrombosis, severe aneurism, acute varicosity, dermatitis or infectious diseases of the skin (including inflammation of the hypodermis).
- Persons with acute neck sprain (whiplash injury)

Persons with any of the following conditions should seek medical advice before using the chair:

- Serious heart conditions
- Sensory impairment caused by serious peripheral circulatory disorders due to diabetes and other diseases
- Osteoporosis, spinal fractures, acute pain and/or symptoms thereof
- Persons having injuries to the parts of the body to be treated
- High fever (38°C or higher) (examples: strong acute inflammation symptoms such as fatigue, chills or blood pressure fluctuation). Any time you feel weak.
- Persons in the early unstable stages of pregnancy, or immediately after giving birth
- Persons who have implanted electronic medical device(s) easily susceptible to electromagnetic interference, e.g. pacemakers
- Abnormal or curved spine
- Persons planning to use the chair for parts of the body that have received or are currently receiving medical treatment
- Persons with malignant tumour/s
- Persons under bed rest orders
- Persons with acute internal complaints or ailments such as gastritis, enteritis, or hepatitis
- Persons under a doctor's care, or those experiencing unusual physical discomfort
- Joint deformation due to rheumatism, gout, or other diseases
- Persons with symptoms such as dizziness, unsteadiness, or tinnitus
- Inflammation due to sprain or torn muscles
- Persons with tendonitis or suspected tendonitis

Elderly people and persons with weak bones, even if they have no particular disease, should seek medical advice before using the chair.

Children, persons unable to express their intentions or physically disabled persons should not be allowed to use the chair unassisted.

Do not allow children and pets to play around the chair (e.g. behind the reclining seat back and under the leg rest) or climb or sit on the chair.

Set-Up

Step 1:

Once you have opened the packaging, check all the parts and tools supplied. Take a few minutes to familiarise yourself with the assembly instructions provided.

Step 2:

Turn the wheel frame over and insert the wheels into the sockets. This may require a little force for the wheels to slot neatly into the sockets.



Step 3:

Once all 5 wheels are securely inserted, turn the frame upright. Insert the gas shaft into the base and place the shaft cover over the top.



Step 4:

Attach the armrests onto the seat using the appropriate screws.

The, right side armrest comes with a fitted pocket to store the remote control.



Step 5:

Slide the back rest into the fittings of the armrests and fasten it with the appropriate screws.



Step 6:

To fit the piston shaft, turn the chair on its side for easier access. Screw the piston shaft onto the back rest with provided screws and nuts. Ensure that no heavy force is applied in any opposing directions that this seat is designed for.



Step 7:

Attach the adjustment lever with provided screws and attach the piston shaft to the base of the seat.



Step 8:

Connect the white cables together and then the multi-pin cable together. The power box can be stored in the rear pocket.

This power box beeps when the remote control buttons are pressed. This box has cavities that are for ventilation and sound travel. This sound cannot be muted or turned down.



Step 9:

Finally, turn the chair the right way up and slot the top of the chair into the piston on the base of the chair.

Insert the power into a mains wall socket.



Operation

1. Once all the cords are connected properly, plug the power pack into a wall socket.
2. Insert AAA batteries into the remote control.
3. Press the power (red) button on the remote.
4. This product features 6 different massaging rhythms. Pressing the "MODE" button cycles through these different modes.
5. This product also features 4 different massaging points; "NECK", "BACK", "THIGH" & "LUMBAR". Pressing these buttons turns off and on that area of massaging.
6. The "INTENSITY" has 3 different levels. Pressing this button goes through the different levels with pressure, in ascending order.
7. The "HEAT" button will turn on and off the heating function. Do NOT use this for longer than 20 mins.
8. The "TIME" button changes the period of time the chair is functioning for. It can be set for 10mins, 15mins or 20mins.
