

## Safety

- DO NOT use near flammable objects.
- DO NOT allow flammable liquids to contact the grill when it is hot.
- DO NOT leave a lit grill unsupervised.
- The grill is for outdoor use only.
- Clean the grill before each use.
- Use the grill on a flat, level surface.
- Use charcoal fires only.
- After use, ensure all fire debris/hot material is extinguished.
- Ensure that the grill is cool and all fire debris is removed before packing and storing.
- Use appropriate gloves and utensils when using the grill.
- Do not allow pets or children near a lit grill.
- Do not move a lit grill.
- Always have water nearby for emergency use.



## Assembly

1. Attach the handle brackets (6) to the handle (8) with screws (9).
2. Mount the handle assembly to the grill cover (2) with screws/nuts (7).
3. Install the four ventilation controls (12) on the inside ends of each grill body with screws/nuts (13).
4. Attach the leg mounts (3) to the outside ends of each grill with screws/nuts (5).

## Set-Up

1. Attach the legs (4) to the leg mounts (4) by sliding the leg tube onto the leg mount tube.
2. Insert the lower and upper grills (10, 11) as needed.
3. If using the grill cover (2) as a secondary grill:
  - a. Rotate the grill cover so it upside-down.
  - b. Attach the remaining legs to the grill cover leg mounts tubes to support it.
  - c. Insert the lower and upper grills (10, 11) as needed.



## Ignition Guide

1. Remove cooking grates and open grill vents
2. Pour enough charcoal on the base of the grill to form an even layer
3. Pile charcoal into a mound for greater coal-to-coal contact
4. Pour a generous amount of lighter fluid on the UNLIT coals
5. Light the coals carefully with a long match or long lighter
6. Once the coal is a white-grey colour with a glowing red centre, deconstruct the mound of charcoal and spread evenly.
7. Replace the cooking grates and begin cooking.
