






# Safety

- Install the BBQ grill on a firm, flat, open ground, away from flammable objects.
- To prevent any accidental fires, put a bucket of water near the BBQ grill.
- Before using the BBQ grill for the first time, heat it up first, keeping the temperature stable for at least 30 minutes.
- Do not start the BBQ grill before clearing the fuel surface of debris and ash.
- Please use a longer handle grip or microwave oven gloves when operating the BBQ grill.
- When the BBQ grill is not being used, clean and dry the various components to prevent rusting.
- Fuel types: Charcoal

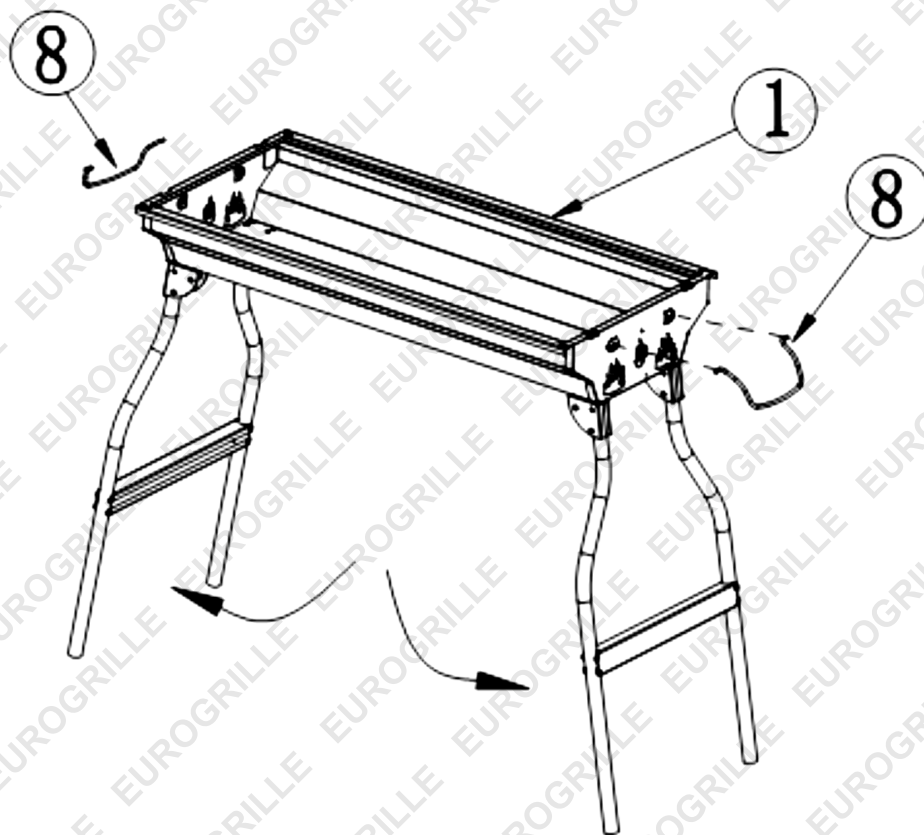
## **WARNING!**

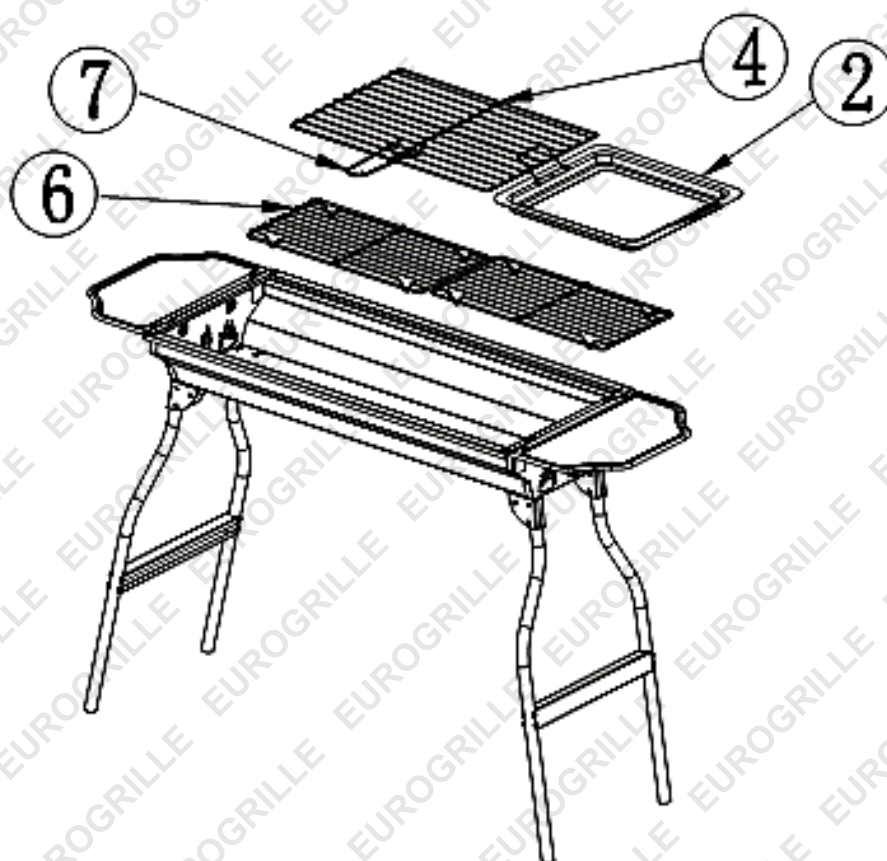
- The BBQ grill can produce carbon monoxide when being used. Do not use it indoors such as in a car, tent or any enclosed space to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning!
- Do not use alcohol, gasoline, kerosene, diesel and other dangerous flammable liquids as fuel to avoid accidents!
- The combustion temperature of the BBQ grill is very high. Please do not move around the BBQ grill and keep pets and children away.
- Never leave open fires unattended. Make sure that the fire has been put out after using the BBQ grill. Completely extinguish the fire first before leaving.
- Used charcoal for fuel; do not pack them for storage. Charcoal should be stored in a dry, well-ventilated place and away from sources of heat and fire.

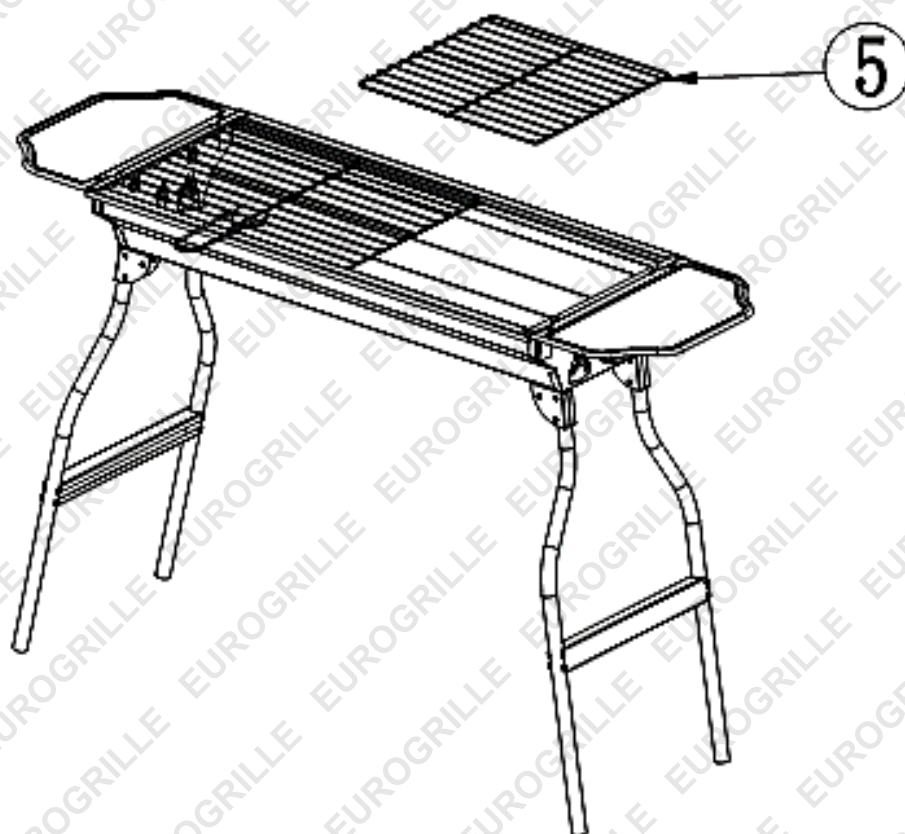

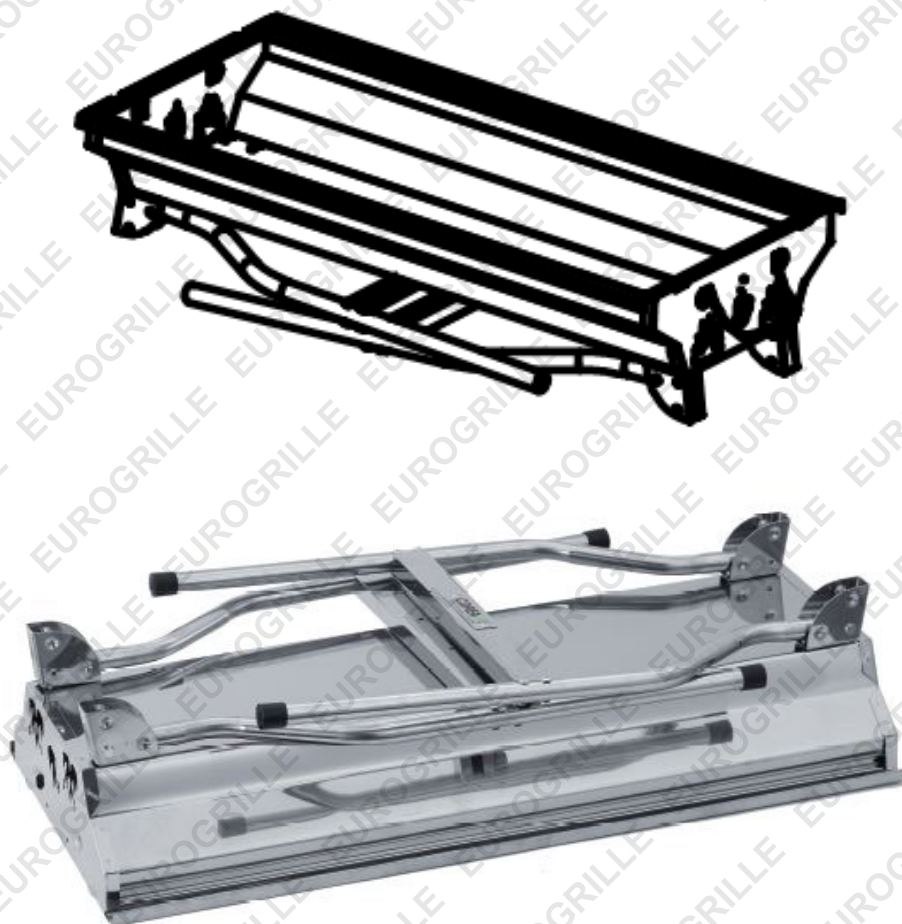
## Set-Up

# Cooking Tips

## Using Lemon Juice

Add a little lemon juice to your barbecue to make them tenderer, moist, nutritious and to give them a distinctive flavour.

## Using Honey

Smear honey on your barbecue not only to add sweetness to the flavour but also to make it more healthful. You can also add lemon juice, black pepper powder, mustard, garlic and other condiments to make delicious and healthy barbecues.

## Using Accessories

- To prevent burns or accidents, you can use microwave oven gloves or other long handle clamps.
- Knives, kitchen scissors and other kitchen utensils are also important aides to cooking your barbecue.
- Barbecue will inevitably have burnt parts. So as not to waste food, you can use the kitchen scissors to cut away the charred parts. They can also be used to cut away the fat from food.
