

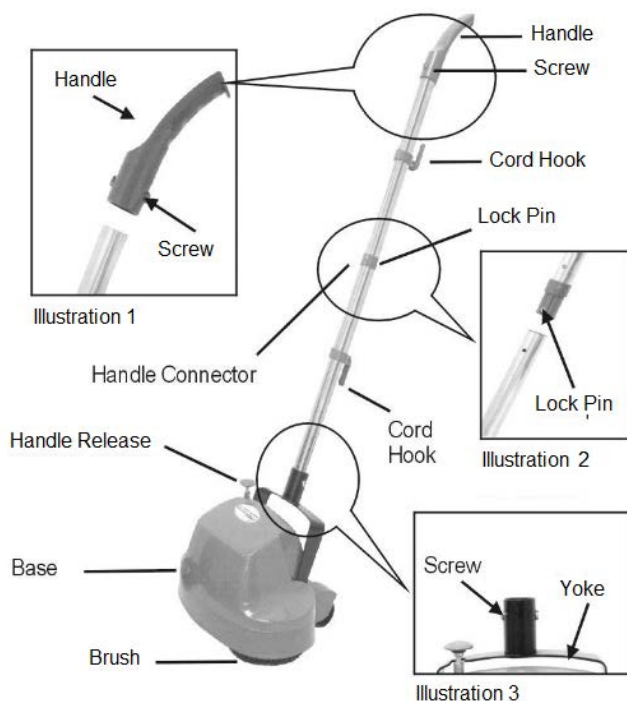
Assembly:

1. Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the screw from the plastic handle. Slide metal tube into the plastic handle, align the holes, reinstall and tighten the screw. (see illustration 1).
2. Locate the other metal handle tube and slip the end with one hole over the plastic handle connector on the finished handle assembly. Make sure the locking pin protrudes through the hole in the side of the lower tube (see illustration 2).
3. Remove the screw from the black painted yoke, and insert the metal handle tube into the yoke. Reinstall the screw, and tighten (see illustration 3).

Operation:

1. **Start the machine:** Step on the handle release pedal and lower the handle to activate the brushes.
2. **Cleaning hard floors:** Place the micro-fibre pads under the brushes, or place the pads on the floor and set the machine on them. The weight of the machine will hold the pads in place. Spray household surface cleaner on a small area of the floor and immediately run the machine over the area. When one side of the pads becomes dirty, flip the pads over and use the opposite side. When both sides of the pad are dirty, they can be cleaned and rinsed in water or cleaned in a washing machine.
3. **Polishing wooden floors:** Attach the felt discs to the brushes using the plastic retaining clips. "Snap" the retaining clip through the centre of each felt disc and onto the shaft to securely retain the disc.
4. **Removing spots and stains from carpets:** Spray a small section of the carpet with a household "spot and stain" remover. Using the brushes, agitate the spot or stain until it is removed.
5. **Cleaning high traffic zones and large spots and stains on carpets:** Attach the felt discs to the brushes using the plastic retaining clips. "Snap" the retaining clip through the centre of each felt disc and onto the shaft to securely retain the disc. Slip the carpet bonnet over each felt disc. Spray the carpet lightly with a household "spot and stain" remover. Run the machine over the area until the stains are removed. Rinse or clean the carpet bonnets as needed.

Parts Identification and Assembly:

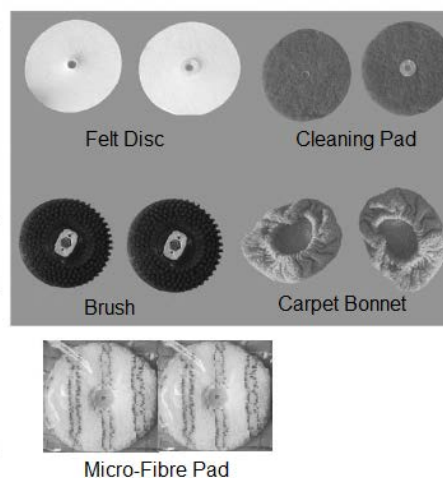


WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or injury:

- Never carry the machine by the electrical cord, or pull on the cord to disconnect the machine from the electrical supply. Instead, grasp the plug, and pull to disconnect.
- Keep the electrical cord away from hot surfaces. Do not pull the cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not close doors on the cord.
- Do not touch moving parts.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended, when plugged in. Disconnect the appliance from the electrical supply when not in use, and before servicing.
- Do not handle the plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Follow all label, and marking instructions.
- Do not allow the product to be used by children. Close attention is needed when product is used near children.
- Do not use if the electrical cord or plug is damaged. If the appliance is malfunctioning, has been dropped, damaged, or exposed to water, take it to an authorized service centre.
- Do not use with, or near flammable liquids.
- Do not store appliance near hot ovens or heating appliances.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments. Do not use for any purpose other than described in this user's guide.
- Make sure the appliance is connected to the correct voltage. The correct voltage is listed on the rating label.
- Do not attempt to repair the product. If repairs are required, take it to an authorised service centre.
- Do not submerge the appliance in water, or other liquid. Do not place, or store the appliance where it can fall, or be pulled into a tub, sink, or other vessel containing liquid. Do not wash the machine.
- If using the machine to polish floor wax. Make sure the wax is completely dry before polishing.
- This machine is equipped with a thermal limiting device to protect the motor from overheating. If the machine suddenly stops operating, disconnect it from the electrical supply and allow it to cool. If the appliance is not disconnected from the electrical supply, it could start unexpectedly when the motor cools.
