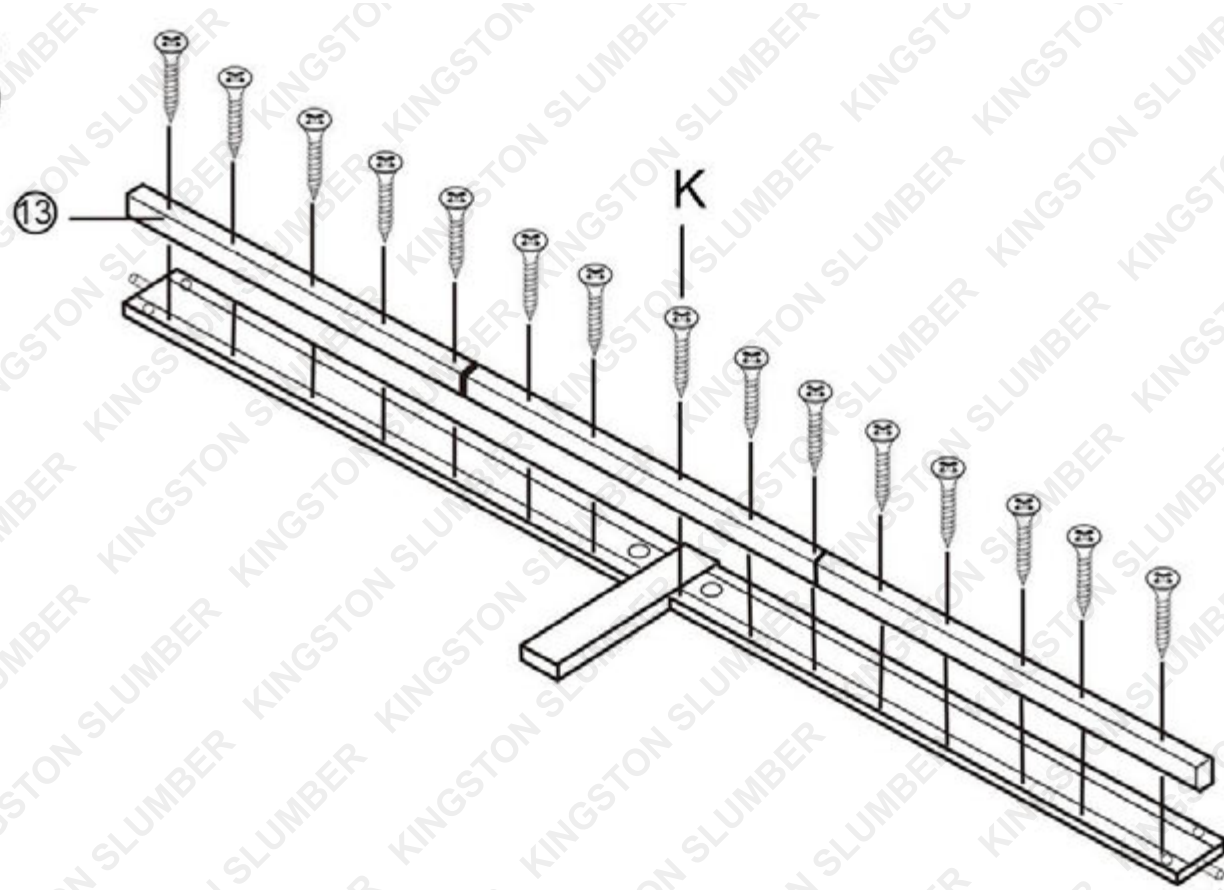
Attention:

- The outer side of the middle leg should be positioned on the outside of the bedside rail.

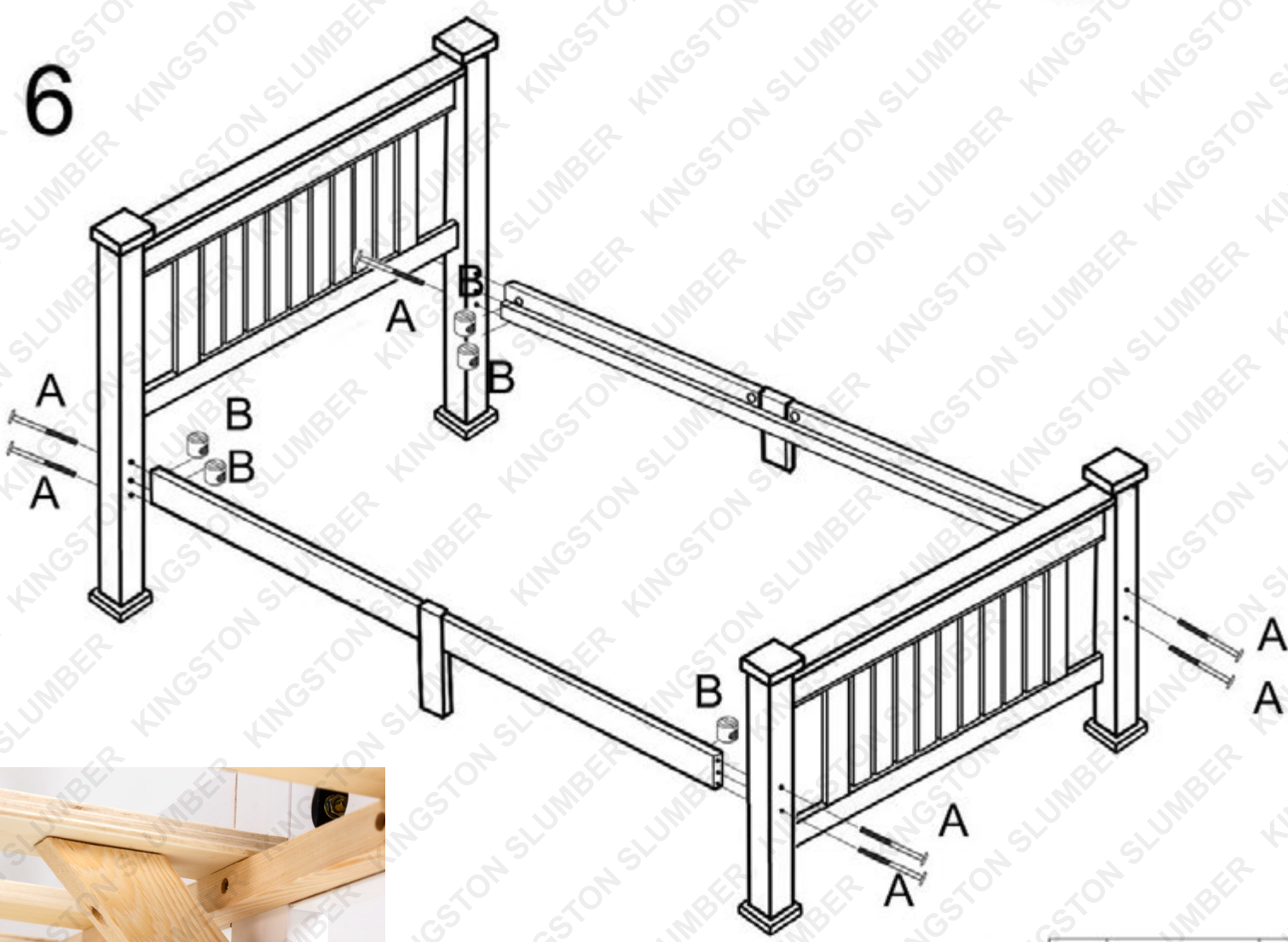

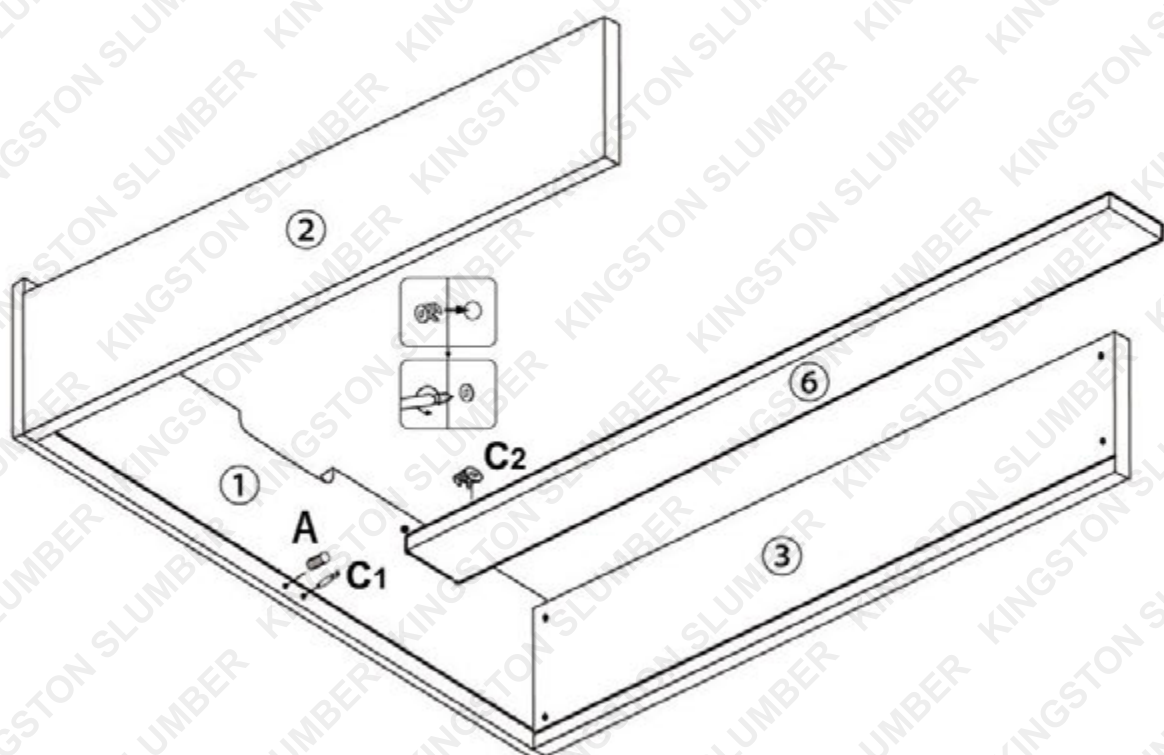
Step 1



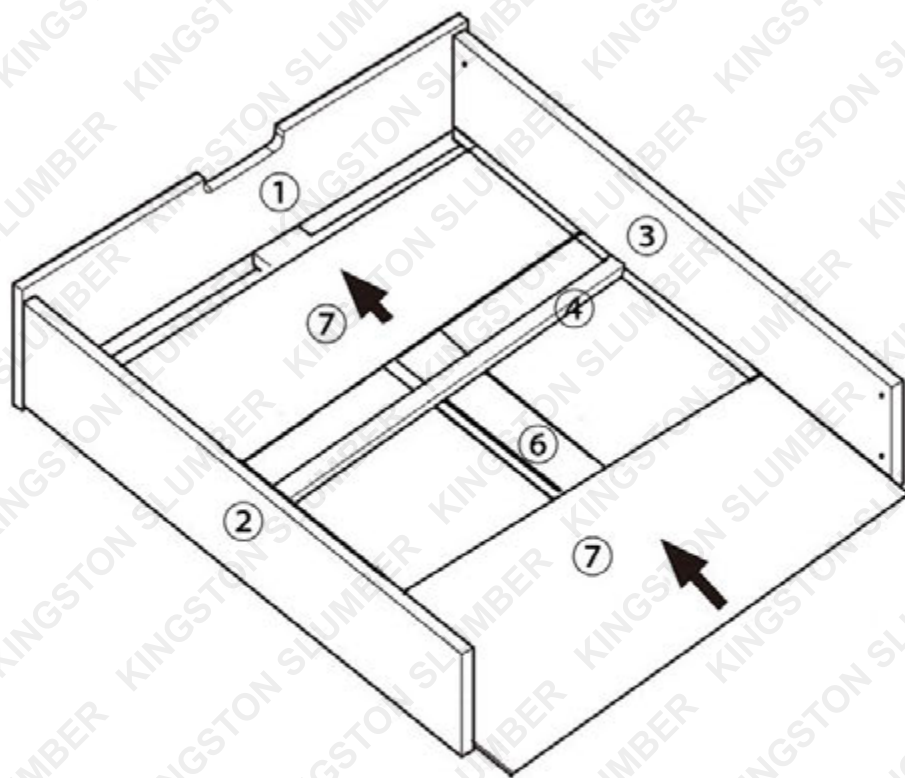
Use the wooden connectors (**Part A**) and bolts (**Part C**) to combine the side (**Part 2&3**) with the front board of the drawers (**Part 1**).

Phillips-head (Crosshead) screwdriver is required.

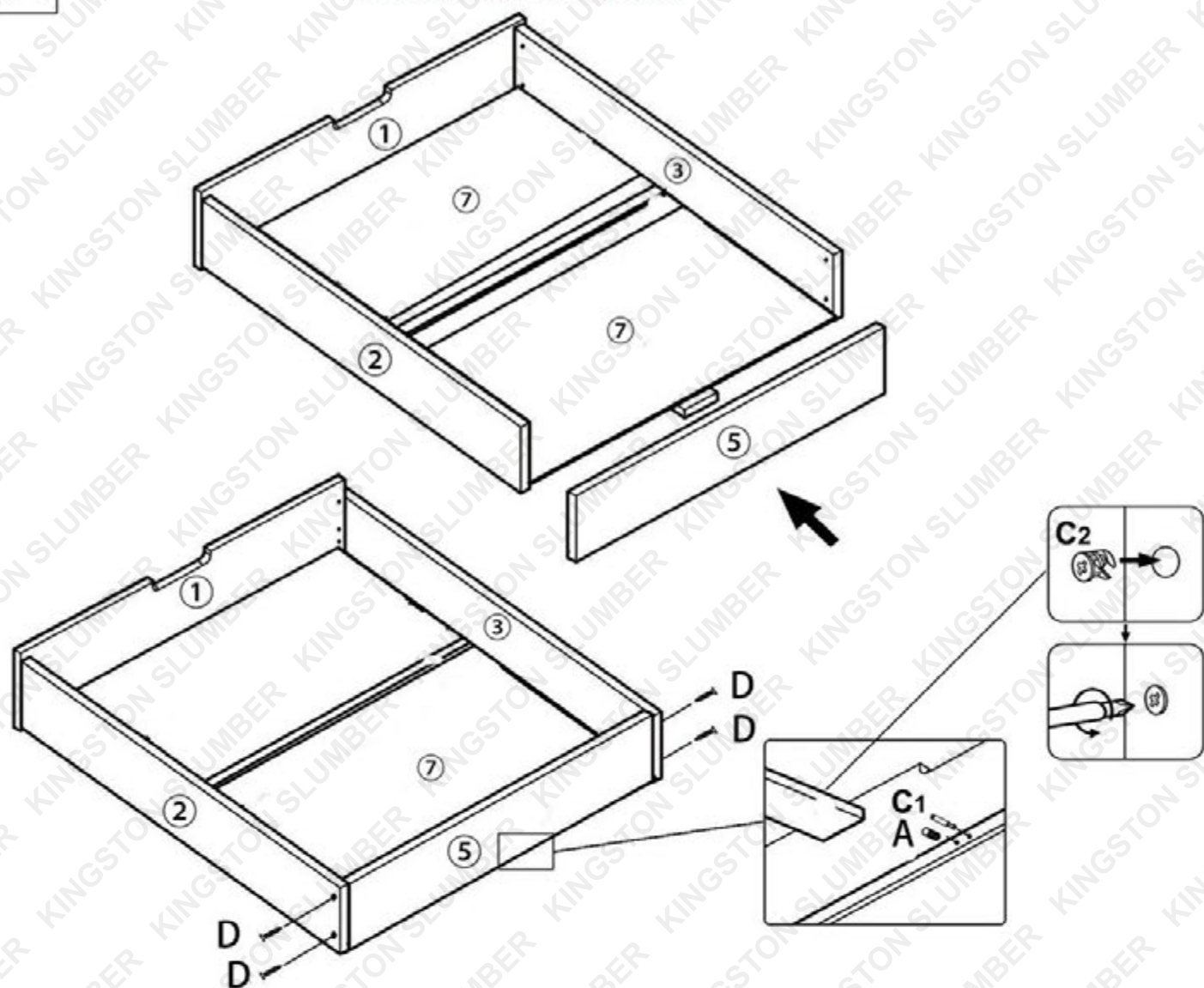


As the illustrated direction, slide the parts (Part 4 & 7) into the assembled parts in step 2.

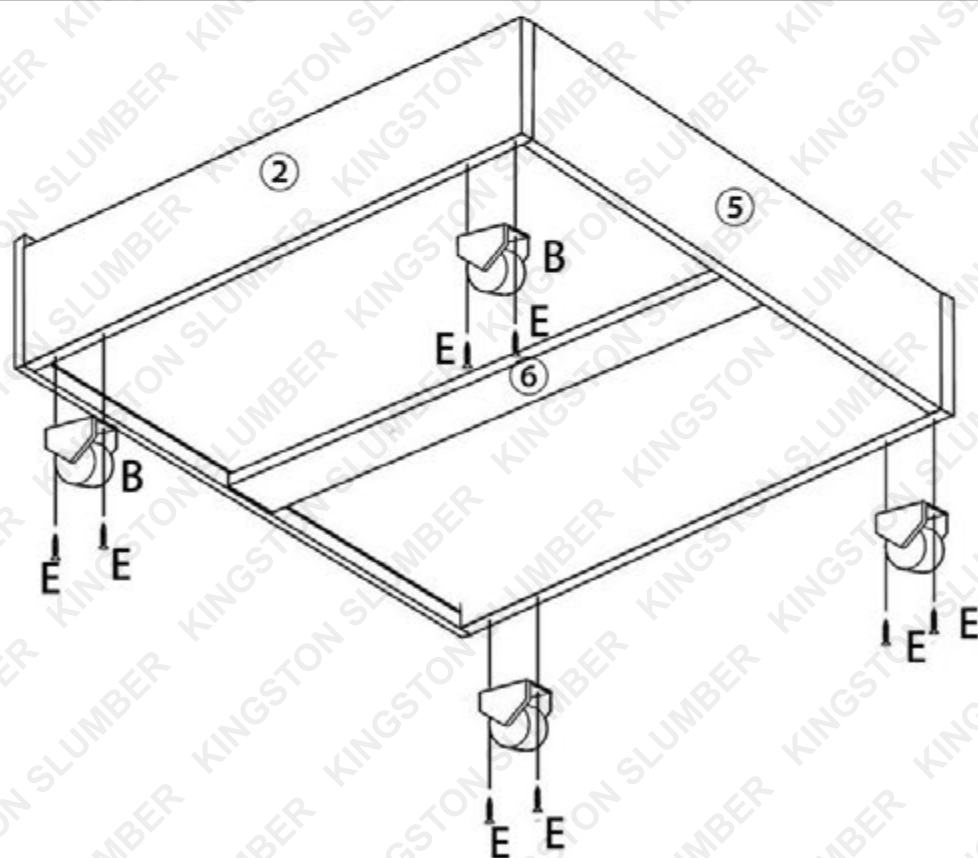
The order is Part 4, Part 7, and lastly Part 7.
