
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PRECAUTIONARY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Maintain the table periodically. Make sure that all screws are secure and the cable has not deteriorated or frayed. Make sure that there are no cracks on the aluminium structure.
2. Do not overload the table beyond the recommended weight limit. This could result in serious injury to the user. This product is tested to hold a maximum working load of 250 kg.
3. Do not use alcohol-based cleaners when cleaning the vinyl. This could cause damage to the vinyl material. Use warm, soapy water and wipe dry.
4. Make sure that when using the table, all four legs are at the same level. Using the legs at different levels can cause the table to be unstable and can cause injury.
5. Do not allow children to assemble or disassemble the massage table unless under adult supervision.
6. Be careful when using sharp objects, as they can pierce the covering. Keep the table's covering away from being pierced by the sharp items.

SETTING UP YOUR TABLE

Steps are shown as the images below:

1. Release the buckle.
2. Lay the table on its side. With the four rubber feet on the floor, open up the table with the four legs extended as fully as possible.
3. Take out all accessories and then lift the table up until all of the legs are on the floor.
4. Put the headrest cradle into the corresponding outlets, position the cradle at an ideal angle for the face to sit comfortably. Lock in position by pressing the lever mechanism down (see figure below). Then put the headrest cushion on the cradle.



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5. Remove the male clip attachments from the straps on the hanging arm rest. Re-attach them by inserting the strap through the underside of the clip's front slot, and down through the upper side of the back slot (see figure below). Then attach the hanged armrest or sling onto the headrest cradle by looping the straps through the bar and connecting the clips.



6. Insert the two side arm supports into the two holes at each side of the table.
7. The table is now ready for use.

The height of table is adjustable by pressing the copper buttons on the legs. All four legs should be done in the same way one by one and make sure that all of the legs are adjusted to the same height level.

CLOSING AND TRANSPORTING YOUR TABLE



1. Take out all accessories.
2. Lay the table on its side with the four rubber feet on the ground.
3. Put all accessories under the elastic straps under the top veneer.
4. Fold the table up and lock the buckle.
5. Put the massage table into the carry bag.
6. Carry the table like suitcase by grasping the handle.

WARNING!

If the frame/legs/table structure is damaged in anyway, you should not use this table. Using this table when damaged may cause harm or serious injury. Seek assistance from a qualified personnel immediately.
