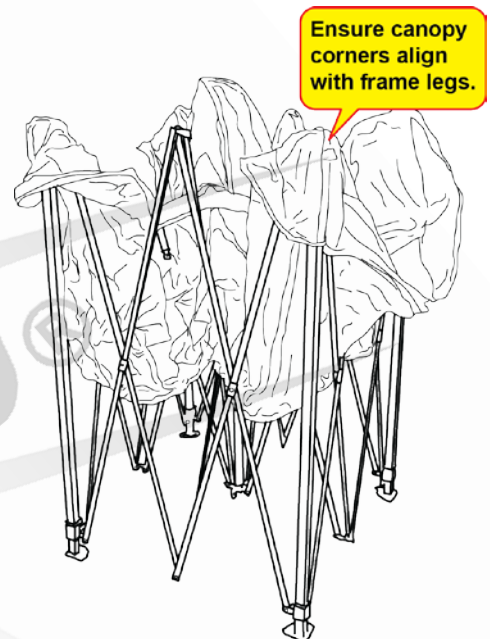


Figure 1 – Unassembled Gazebo

Included Items

- Gazebo frame.
- Gazebo canopy.
- Securing pegs and guy-ropes.

Assembly


1. Stand the gazebo frame upright in the centre of the location where it is to be erected.
2. Carefully place the gazebo canopy over the frame so that the centre and corners are lined up with the frame as shown in Figure 1.
3.  At each corner of the gazebo frame, gently slip the canopy over the frame leg and be sure to firmly attach the canopy to the leg with the Velcro sections. See Figure 2.

Please Turn Over

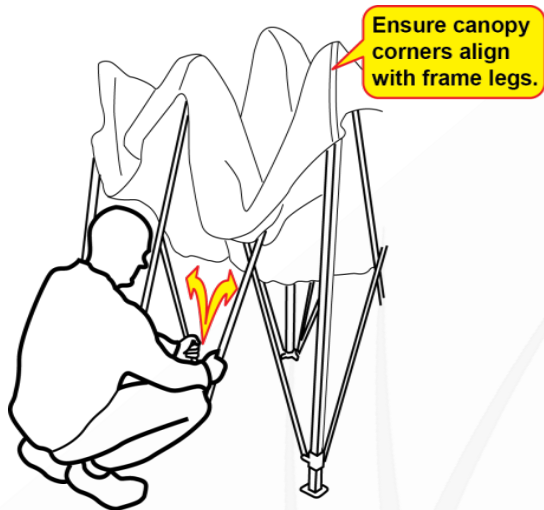


Figure 3 - Hold Frame to Expand

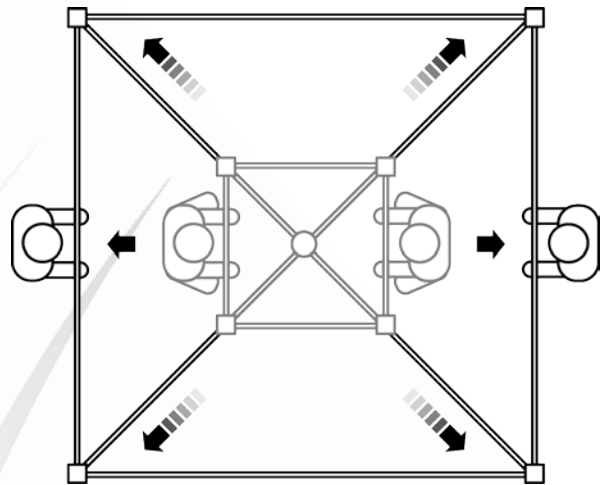


Figure 4 - Expanding the Frame

4. **⚠ This step requires two persons.** On opposite sides of the gazebo, grab the middle section of the gazebo frame in both hands as shown in Figure 3. Simultaneously lift the sections of frame up and slowly move backwards, allowing the frame to expand to its full size as shown in Figure 4.

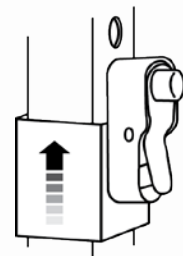
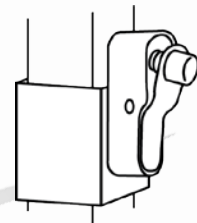


Figure 5 - Tube Lock

- At each leg, secure the top part of the frame to the leg – raise the top part of the frame until the location pin in the tube lock pops into its hole as shown in Figure 5.
- Secure the canopy sides to the frame using the elastic and clips.
- Raise the gazebo roof to the required height by holding the bottom part of the leg to the ground and raising the telescopic section up until the tube lock location pin pops into the next hole. Perform this operation on all legs before raising the roof to the next hole.
- Once the gazebo is assembled and the roof extended to the required height, secure the legs to the ground using the supplied pegs.
- Tie the guy-ropes to the eyelets on the canopy (usually at each frame leg) and secure the other end to the ground using the supplied pegs.

⚠ Do not leave the gazebo unattended. Disassemble the gazebo immediately if weather conditions begin to affect it.

Disassembly

Disassembly is a reverse of the assembly procedure. Note that to release the frame tube location pin, press the button at the top of the tube lock then slide the smaller tube inside the larger one as required.

Care and Maintenance

The gazebo should be carefully disassembled and stored in a dry location. If the canopy or gazebo frame is wet, allow it to dry before storing it. It is also recommended to clean any parts of the gazebo that may be excessively dirty before storing it.
