



Mobile 88-Piece Double-Sided Parts Bin Rack

User Guide

Safety

- This unit is not a toy and should be kept out of the reach of children.
- Small parts are included that may pose a choking hazard to children and animals. Keep parts away from children and pets.
- Before assembly, ensure there are no missing or defective parts. Contact the retailer if any parts are missing or defective.
- Assemble only as instructed in this guide. Any deviation or shortcut may lead to incorrect assembly or be considered customer misuse. Improper assembly may cause damage or serious injury.
- Do not mount the unit to a vehicle.
- Do not over-tighten mounting screws or parts during assembly as this may damage the unit.

WARNING

- The unit should only be positioned on a flat, level and stable surface.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity as this may result in damage or serious injury. Load capacity:
Small bins = 1.5kg (each)
Medium bins = 2.0kg (each)
Large bins = 2.5kg (each)
Top tray = 10kg
Overall capacity = 151kg
- For stability, heavier items should always be placed in the lower bins.
- Do not rest or support items against or on the unit.

CAUTION

- To ensure continued safety, regularly check that the unit is secure and safe to use (every 3 months). Take appropriate action to rectify any unstable or unsafe units.
- If you do not understand this guide, or have any doubts regarding safety of the assembly, seek advice and guidance from a qualified person.
- Appropriate protective equipment, such as safety glasses, must be worn and precautions taken when installing this product.
- It is recommend that two persons install the unit.
- Before installation, ensure the supporting surface will safely support the combined weight of the unit and all stored items. If unsure, contact a qualified contractor for guidance.

Cleaning and Care

Clean the unit using a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh or abrasive chemicals as this can damage surface finishes.

Included Items

1. Frame Leg x2	10. Handle Bracket x2
2. Bin Support Rail x14	11. M4x10 Screw x34
3. Vertical Support Rail x2	12. M6x10 Screw x26
4. Top Tray x1	13. M6x35 Screw x4
5. Base x1	14. M6 Nut x28
6. Frame Support Bracket x4	15. M6x15 Screw x2
7. Castor with Brake x2	16. Small Bin x64
8. Castor x2	17. Medium Bin x18
9. Handle x1	18. Large Bin x6



Assembly

1. Attach the castors (7 and 8) to the underside of the base (5). Place the braked castors on one long side of the base, and the non-braked castors on the other side, then fasten using 16 M6x10 screws (12) and nuts (14).

2. Position the frame legs (1) on the inside of the base. **Note:** The bin support rail mounting holes on the frame legs should face inwards.

3. Fasten the frame legs to the base using 4 M6x35 screws (13) and nuts (14).

4. Attach the frame support brackets (6) to the base using 4 M6x10 screws (12) and nuts (14). Attach the support brackets to the frame legs using 2 M6x15 screws (15) - each screw passes through both brackets then into the frame leg.

5. Attach 7 bin support rails (2) to one side of the frame legs. To attach a rail, insert the pins on the sides of the rail into the larger diameter part of the rail mounting holes in the frame legs, then slide the rail downward so the pins sit in the slotted part of the rail mounting holes.


6. Attach a vertical support rail (3) to the backs of the bin support rails installed in step 5 using 7 M4x10 screws (11).

7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 for the remaining bin support rails and vertical support rail.

8. Place the top tray (4) into position on top of the frame legs. Secure the tray to the legs using 4 M6x10 screws (12) and nuts (14).

9. Attach a handle bracket (10) to the frame leg using 1 M6x10 screw (12). Hold the handle (9) in position against the installed bracket, then attach the remaining handle bracket to the handle and frame leg using 1 M6x10 screw (12). When installed correctly, the handle should be trapped between the two brackets.

10. Arrange the storage bins as required (larger ones on the lower rails). Hook each bin to the top lip of the bin support rail and ensure it is secure before using it.
