Safety

- This equipment is for domestic use only.


Unfolding

Using the handle, hold the trolley so it is resting on the corner of the platform ①.

Place your foot on the top edge of the platform and push the platform downward

② - as the platform moves down, the wheels unfold. When the platform is fully unfolded, the trolley is ready for use.

Squeeze the upper handle sections together ③ and pull up to extend the handle ④ - there are 2 possible positions.



Folding

Place your foot under the front edge of the platform and push the platform upward - as the platform moves up, the wheels fold.

Squeeze the upper handle sections together and push down to retract the handle.

Care and Maintenance

Clean using a soft cloth and suitable cleaner (do not use solvents or abrasives).
