



Multi-Drawer Tool Cabinets / Chests

Safety

- Do not modify or use the tool for any other purpose than that it is designed for.
- Keep work areas clean, well lit and well ventilated.
- Do not operate the equipment if it is damaged, malfunctioning or is in an excessively worn state.
- This equipment must be used on flat, level and stable surfaces only. Do not use if it is unsteady.
- Stay alert and use common sense when operating equipment. Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times. Do not use equipment when tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. This equipment is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacities.
- This equipment is for domestic use only.

Parts Identification

Supplied parts may vary between models are a tool chest, or a tool cabinet, or chest and cabinet combination.

- Tool cabinets come supplied with 4 casters, handle and handle fasteners. Some models may include several external hanging hooks.
- Tool chests, if not supplied fully assembled, come supplied with 2 handles and handle fasteners.
- Tool chest and 2-drawer cabinets may come supplied with the tool chest inside the cabinet - these types have a removable panel that allows the chest to be removed from the cabinet cavity.
- Locks come supplied with keys.
- Tool chests come with locking bars.

Note: Tools are not included.



Assembly

Note: Ensure that all parts are included and are in good condition before assembly. • Some parts may come pre-assembled. • Tools, not supplied, may be required for assembly.

For tool cabinets shipped with a tool chest in the cabinet, remove the panel on the side of the cabinet (4 screws) and any shipping fasteners securing the chest to the cabinet (Fig 1). Slide the chest from the cabinet, then re-install the panel on the side of the cabinet (4 screws) (Fig 2).

Attach the castors to the underside of the cabinet by pushing or tapping them in until they "lock" into position (Fig 3).

If the chest requires the handles to be installed, place a handle into position on each side of the chest and secure it using 4 screws (Fig 4).

Attach the cabinet handle to the side of the cabinet (either side may be used on some models) - place the handle into position on the side of the cabinet and secure it using 4 screws (Fig 5).

If the cabinet has hanging hooks, attach them as required to the side of the cabinet (either side may be used on some models) as required (Fig 6).













Care and Maintenance

Periodically check that all fasteners are tight. • Clean using a soft cloth and suitable cleaner (do not use solvents or abrasives, particularly on the seat).

If it becomes necessary to remove a drawer, pull the drawer out fully, then back in slightly. On each side of the drawer, insert a screwdriver into the slot in the bearing slide and push it against the drawer stopper until it clears the prong in the bearing slide, then pull the drawer out slightly. To re-install a drawer, carefully push it on to the bearing slide so that stopper engages the prong and clips into the slot in the bearing slide (Fig 7).


