



# Rolling Tool Box / Stool

## User Guide

### Safety

Read and understand this user guide before using the equipment. Retain the user guide for future reference.

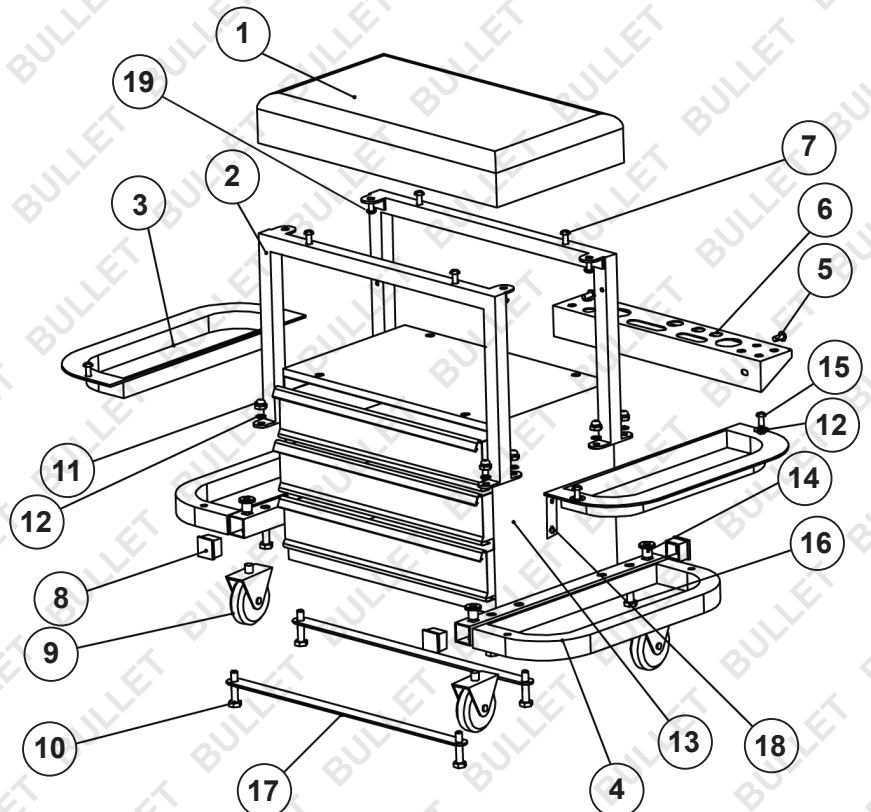
**Any damage or equipment failure due to incorrect usage is not covered by warranty.**

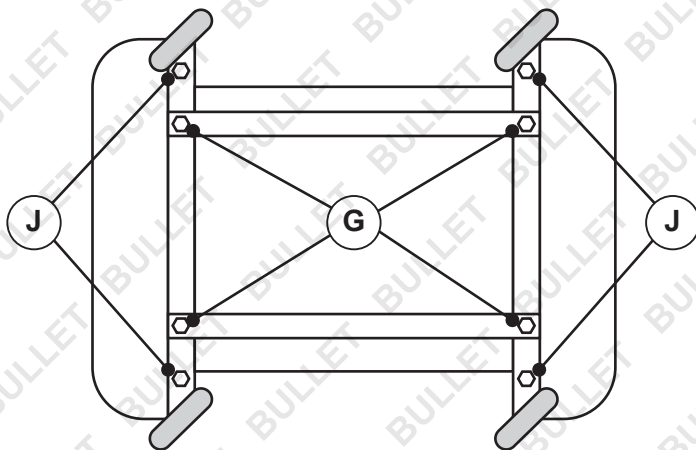
## Assembly

**Note:** Ensure that all parts are included and are in good condition before assembly. • Some parts may come pre-assembled. • Tools, not supplied, may be required for assembly.

1. Assemble the 4 castors (A) to the underside of the 2 castor / side tray frames (B), then secure with 4 sleeve nuts (C). Use an Allen key to tighten the nuts.

2. Assemble the 2 castor / side tray frame assemblies (D) and 2 support bars (E) to the cabinet / drawer assembly (F). Attach the parts by inserting M8x40 bolts (G) from the underside of the support bars, through the *inner* mounting holes of the castor / side tray frame assemblies, then through the *inner* mounting holes of the cabinet / drawer assembly. Secure the parts using M8 washers (H) and M8 acorn nuts (I). Use suitable spanners to tighten the fasteners.

3. Insert M8x35 bolts (J) from the underside of the castor side tray assemblies (D), *outer* mounting holes, then through the *outer* mounting holes of the cabinet / drawer assembly (F). Secure the parts using M8 washers (H) and M8 acorn nuts (I). Use suitable spanners to tighten the fasteners.

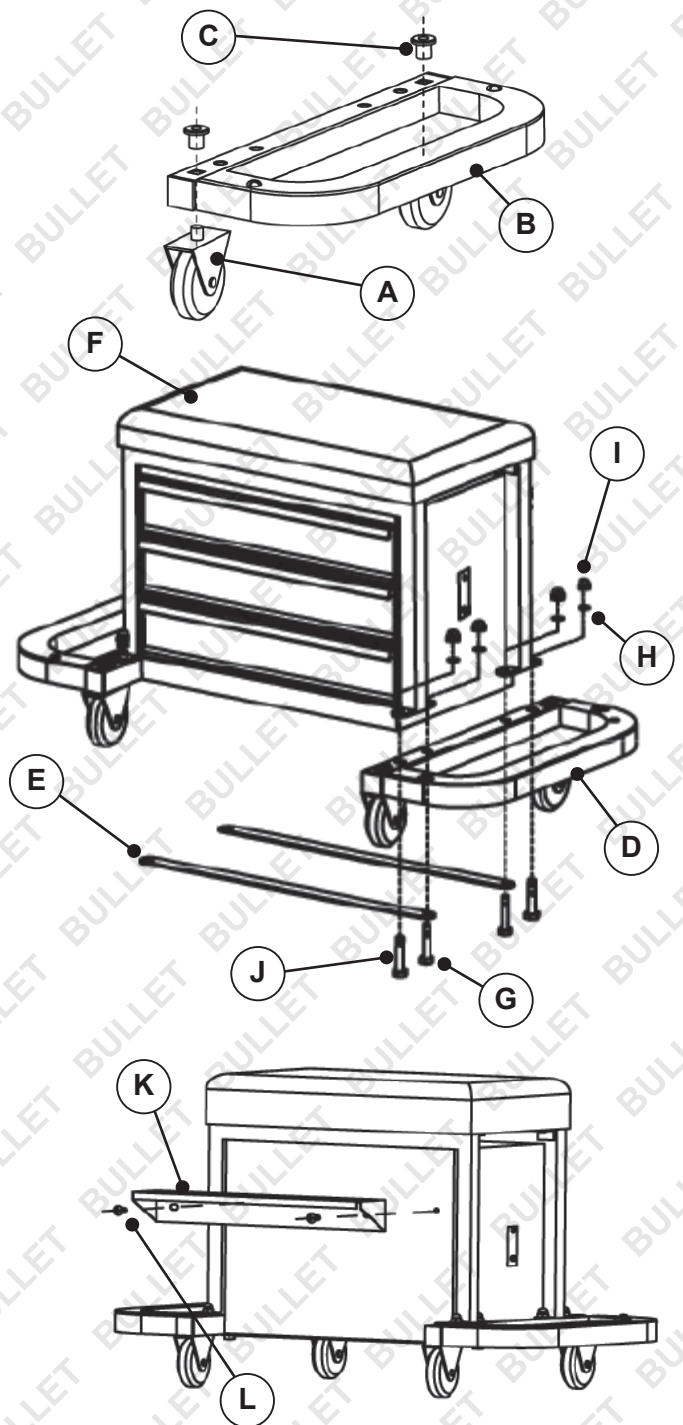


4. Assemble the tool shelf (K) to the rear of the cabinet using 2 M6x10 bolts (L). Use a suitable spanner to tighten the fasteners.

Assembly is complete and the product is ready for use. Be sure not to exceed the maximum rated weights. When not using the side trays, fold them up and secure them to the cabinet sides with the straps.

## Care and Maintenance

Periodically check that all fasteners are tight. • Clean using a soft cloth and suitable cleaner (do not use solvents or abrasives, particularly on the seat).
